The Stoop

A large stepped area, or “reverse stoop,” creates a generous, versatile space for performances, panel discussions, film screenings, and lectures.

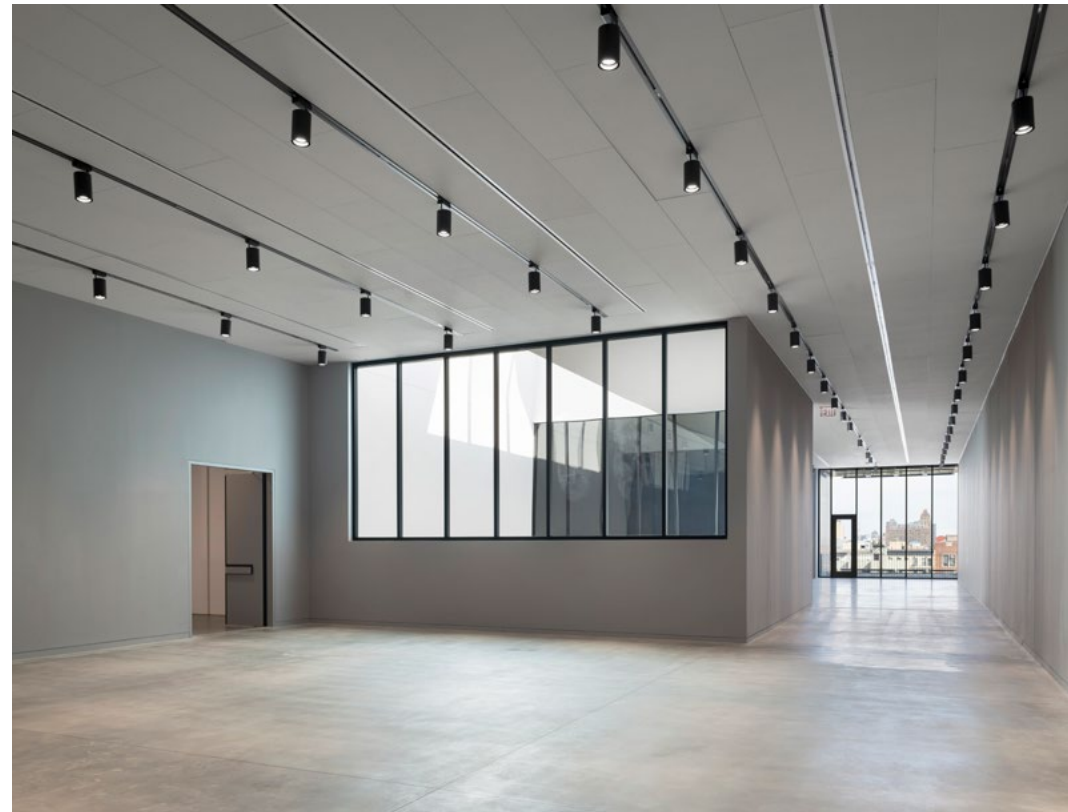
